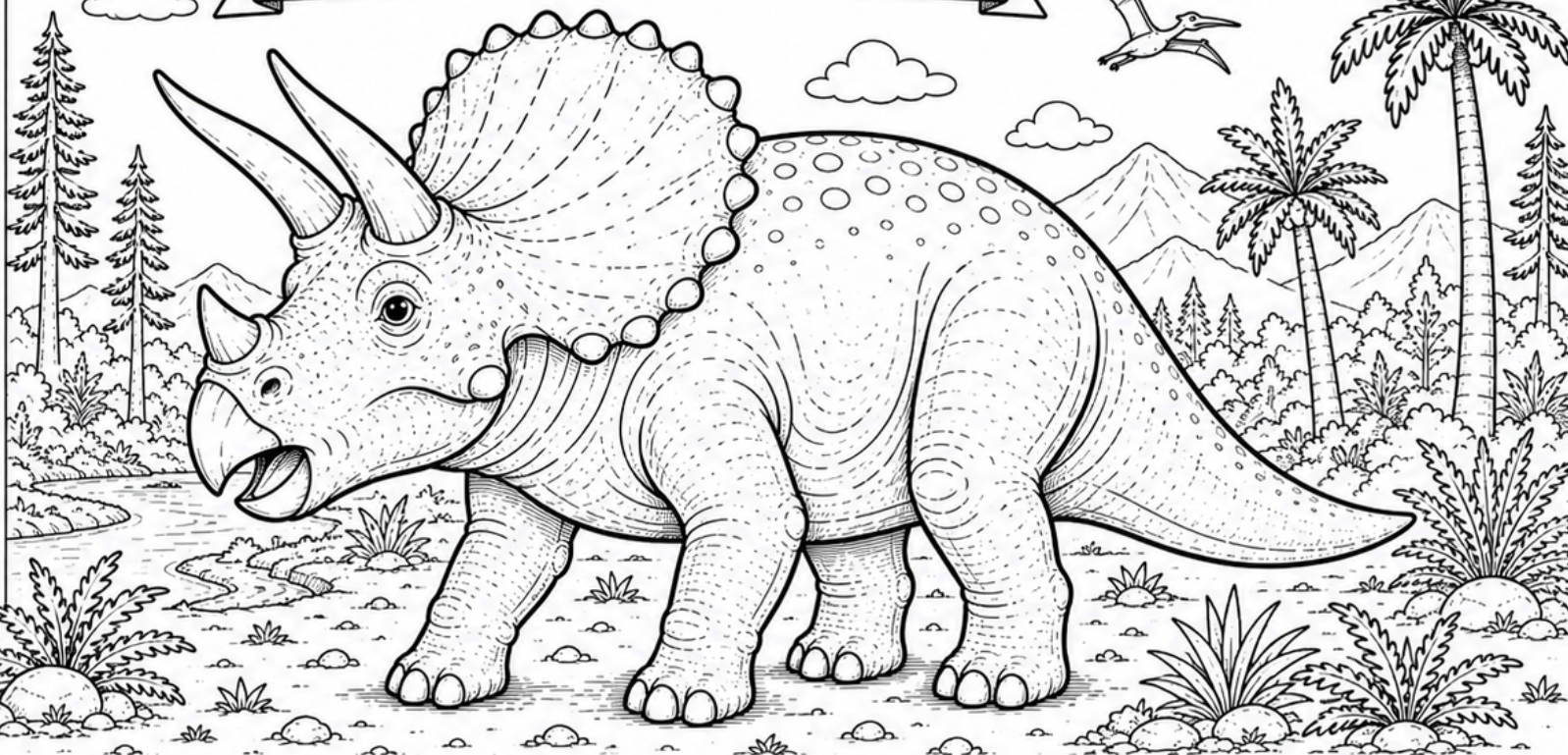


TRICERATOPS

- It had a large bony frill at the back of its head.
- Its strong beak was well suited for cropping plants.
- It had hundreds of closely packed teeth for processing tough vegetation.
- Triceratops lived at the same time as Tyrannosaurus rex!

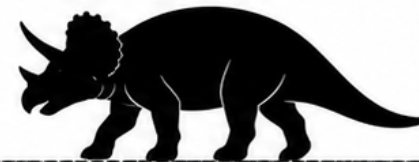
