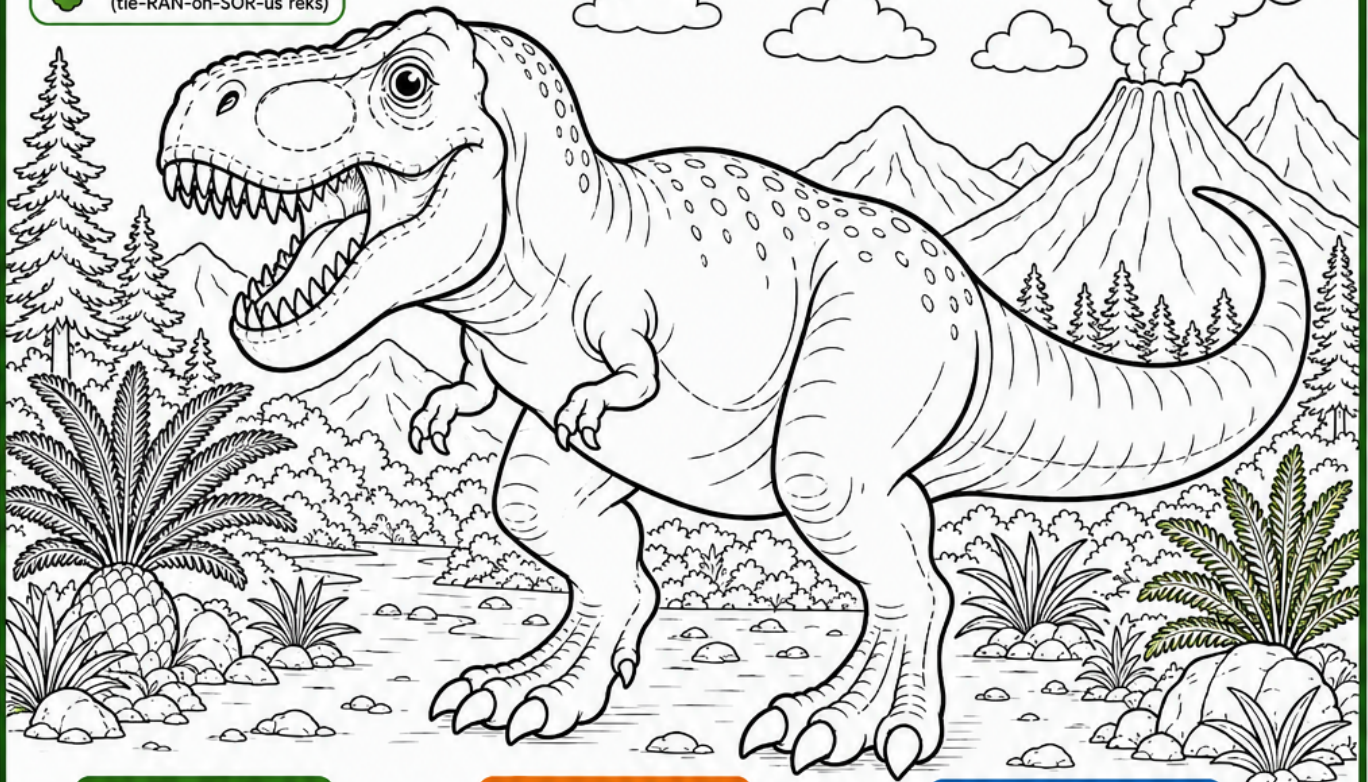

ABOUT T. REX

Tyrannosaurus rex, or T. rex, was one of the largest meat-eating dinosaurs.

It lived during the Late Cretaceous Period, about 68 to 66 million years ago.

Its name means "tyrant lizard king".



AMAZING FACTS



T. rex had a huge skull up to 1.5 metres long and powerful jaws full of sharp, banana-shaped teeth.



It had tiny arms with only two fingers, but strong, powerful legs helped it move quickly.



T. rex was a carnivore, which means it ate other animals.



It could grow up to 12 metres long and weigh up to around 8 tonnes (8,000 kg)!

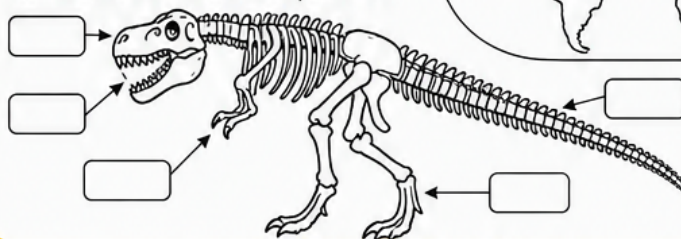
