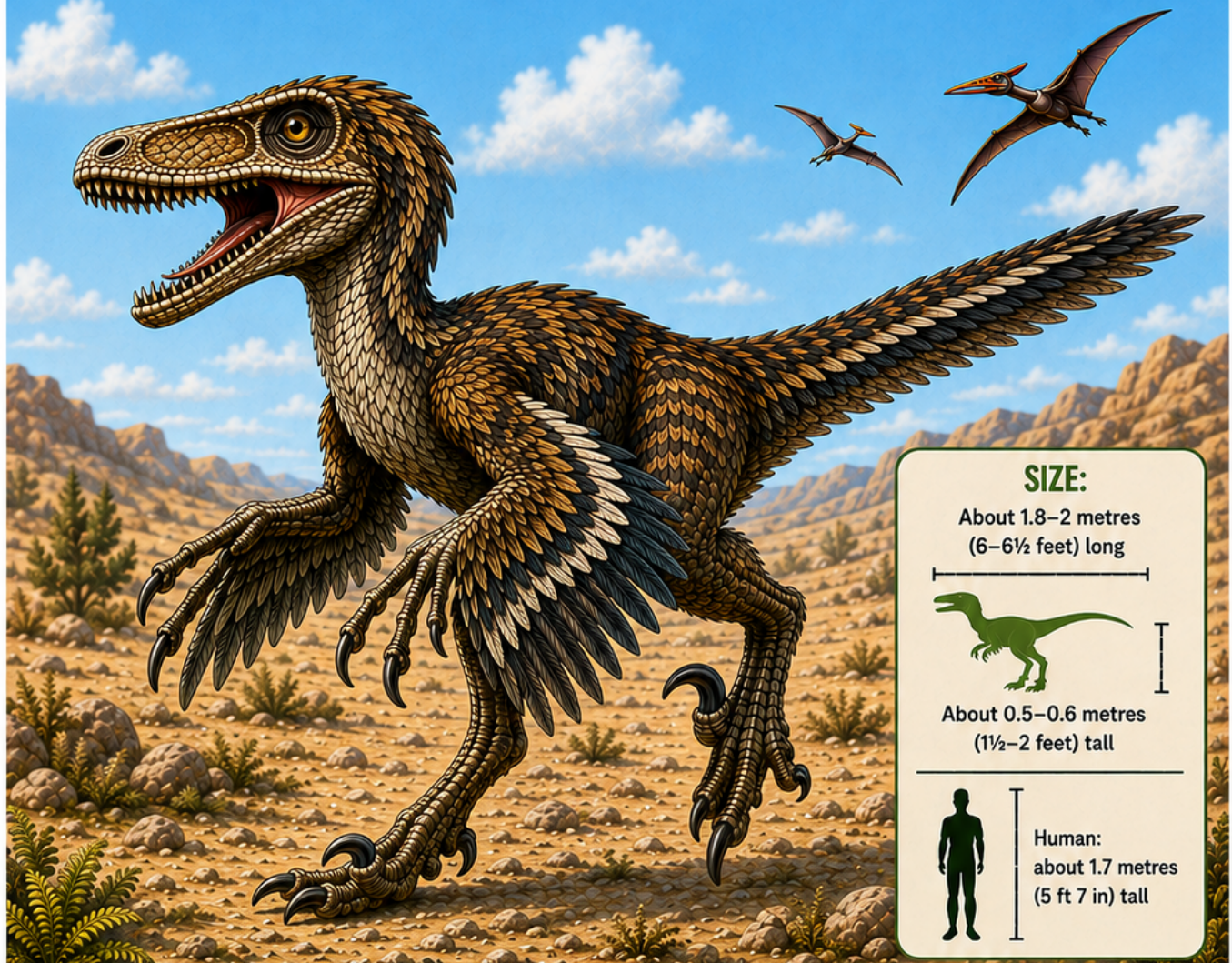


VELOCIRAPTOR

A SMALL, AGILE PREDATOR OF THE LATE CRETACEOUS



SIZE:

About 1.8–2 metres
(6–6½ feet) long



About 0.5–0.6 metres
(1½–2 feet) tall



Human:
about 1.7 metres
(5 ft 7 in) tall



LATE CRETACEOUS

Velociraptor lived during the Late Cretaceous Period, about 75–71 million years ago.



WHERE IT LIVED

Fossils have been found in what is now Mongolia in Asia.



SICKLE CLAW

Each foot had a large, curved sickle claw that may have helped Velociraptor grip and restrain prey.



DIET

A carnivore that ate other animals, including small dinosaurs.



AMAZING FACT

Fossil evidence shows that Velociraptor had feathers, although it could not fly.
